The Electives Network

We are delighted to welcome The Electives Network [<u>https://www.electives.net/</u>] as a new subscriber to Causeway. They help health care students prepare for and manage their overseas "electives" and, over the last twenty years, have had the privilege of connecting healthcare professionals from around the world. They see their work as enabling the development of interconnected and robust health systems which benefit from the skill sharing and system building that such networks entail.

The Electives network are using Causeway to develop online preparatory and training materials for health care students undertaking overseas "electives". They are also using Causeway to develop a pioneering Global Health course for Foundation years doctors.

Causeway 2.5

It is finally here, Causeway 2.5! We wanted to make it "just right". There are a number of "under the bonnet" enhancements as well as some really useful new features as outlined below:

Ordered List element - Get students to rank order a list of items.

Card Stack - you can create a stack of "flash cards" that students can use to quiz themselves repeatedly about any topic. Incorrect answers are returned to a stack which students can re-visit until they get it right.

Pop-up Functionality - we have made a few enhancements to the pop-up feature in the text editor which we introduced in 2.4. You can now choose where the pop-up appears and you can set the pop-up back-ground colour. You can also specify if the pop-up persists until manually closed.
